

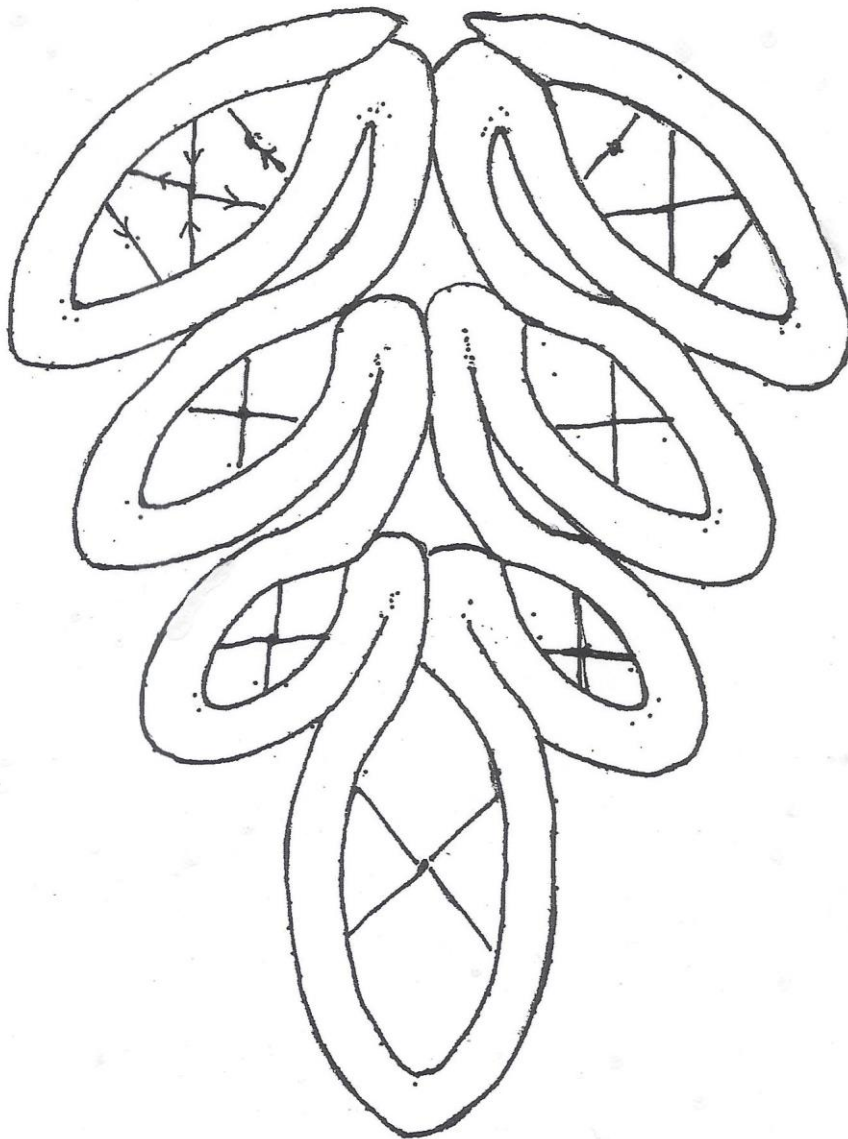
Summer Memories

Lace Demo in 1910 Style



Ready to demonstrate lacemaking at the Heritage Park Historical Village in Calgary, Alberta. I'm wearing the tape lace jabot.

Details for the pattern:

I used 5 pairs of Bockens linen 60/2 for the trails, and some extra pairs for the fillings. The first time I tried the pattern I carefully pricked the holes in advance, but I soon discovered that with so many curves I had to change the pin locations all the time.

For the second attempt I simply drew the outline of the pattern and inserted the pins wherever they needed to go.

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
