




Vera's Pin Cushion 2010


Supplies: DMC tapestry wool; Penelope double canvas 10/inch, tan colour; tapestry needle.

Note: Penelope canvas can be used for petit point designs, use single threads for 20/inch.

Suggested threads: DMC medium pink #3326 or #3716; DMC light pink #963; DMC Black #310;

DMC medium turquoise #3810; DMC light turquoise #598. A narrow lace border could be attached.

Design Your Own Pin Cushion!



This is a design exercise. Use this blank Excel grid to design your own pin cushion!

1. Print the above grid to create your own pattern. Find the center of the grid.
2. Start your design at the center. Use Home: Font colour "fill" for your colour. Click "no fill" to remove.
3. Add new designs further out from the center. Repeat the same patterns in all four directions.
4. An option is to create a pattern with swirls or curves with no repeats. Have fun stitching your design.
